A song starts playing loudly over the PA. She walks down the aisle to U2's "I Still Haven't Found What I'm Looking For".



In J. Golden Kimball's day, the General Authorities were not told in advance when they would be called on to speak in general conference.



The old man looked at his wife and said, "You and your bran muffins. I could have been here ten years ago!"


